Jaipur

The home city of the royal family, Jaipur has long been one of India's crown jewels—and in our small group, we'll explore every facet. When sunlight illuminates its rosy sandstone buildings, you can see why Jaipur has been nicknamed the "Pink City." The city's many enduring sights include the honeycombed sandstone windows of the Palace of the Wind, the mirror-embossed Sheesh Mahal room at the Amber Fort-Palace, and the still-accurate 18th-century sundials at the Jantar Mantar astronomical observatory.

Ranthambore

Once the playground of Indian maharajas—whose pavilions and hunting lodges still dot the lush landscape—Ranthambore National Park was declared a wildlife sanctuary 50 years ago. As your small group traverses the evocative landscape, you're sure to cross paths with some of the many memorable creatures in the jungle, perhaps encountering the rare Bengal tiger, leopards, striped hyenas, nilgai (Indian antelope), sloth bears, mongooses, snub-nosed marsh crocodiles, pythons, and more than 250 species of birds.

Varanasi

For 4,000 years, Hindu pilgrims have come to this holiest of places, one of the world's oldest inhabited cities. At the heart of the city is the River Ganges, where pilgrims flock to the bathing ghats for ritual purification rites each year. You'll witness this devotion both at sunset on a visit to the sacred aarti light ceremony on the riverbanks and at sunrise on a pre-dawn cruise, with your O.A.T. local Trip Leader there to explain the rich symbolism of what you're seeing.


